



Bodegas Grant, located in the heart of the town of El Puerto de Santa María, has been owned by the same family since 1841. Edmundo Grant is the current generation caring for the bodega. The Grant family are former almacenistas who only recently began to estate bottle. Although they do not own any vineyards, they primarily source grapes from the famed Pago Valvaina. Their label, La Garrocha, refers to a famous dance performed with a stick while on horseback.



Oloroso La Garrocha

Grapes: Palomino

Solera Aging: 9 years

Vinification: The Oloroso La Garrocha has spent nine years aging through the Solera system. The microclimate of the bodega produces a distinct environment that gives this sherry its unique characteristics.

Serving Recommendation: La Garrocha Oloroso should be served at European room temperature (68°F).
